

# TRIFOLD MUSEUM DOOR & & WINDOW PATTERNS

I enlarged the windows and window tops as much as they would enlarge on a 9x12 sheet of cardstock.

Microsoft Word gives you the measurements when a picture is inserted, and the measurements can be adjusted, if needed. Cut out the sections in the windows where there glass is seen. Put your own class pictures behind the windows. Some of your nature/science photos would be fitting for a museum. Staten Island Children's Museum has a large insect section. That was why I chose that subject. This trifold museum is made to look similar to the older section of Staten Island Children's Museum.

The first pattern (page 2) is a window. Pages 3 & 4 are the bottom and top parts of the front door.
